PARENT TIME



Have you ever thought of your life as a great adventure? Think about it. Adventures have exciting points. They have low points. They are full of anticipation and emotion. Adventures are awesome, and your life is one. And, we all

know adventures are better with ones we love. Our lives are the greatest adventures, and the One who loves us the most is right there with us, every step of the way.

What's even more awesome is that God has a plan for our great adventure, and it is perfect. God's way may not always be easy, but it is perfect. We're teaching your preschoolers that 'God's way is perfect' by following the life of Moses. Take some time this month to open your Bibles to the book of Exodus and read about Moses' great adventure. Then, pray and ask God to show you the way you should go just as He showed Moses and enjoy the adventure God has written for you.

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MORNING TIME

This month let your child wake up to, "Good morning! Who's ready to go God's way today? I am!"



CAR TIME

This month for drive time, talk about the way you are going with your child as you drive. As you talk about

going "this way and that way," tell your child that when we go God's way we are always going the right way, because God's way is perfect!



BATH TIME

Play the "Sink or Float" game during bath time. Gather several small objects that will sink or float in

water. Ask your child, "Will it sink or float?" before they drop each item in the water. Talk about how Moses' mommy made a special basket for him so he would be safe near the water.



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray. "Dear God, You are such an amazing God! You think and do things that

are so much bigger than the way we think or do. Thank You for loving us and showing us Your way. Help (*name of child*) to have the wisdom to listen to Your way and the courage to go Your way. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



PLAY TIME

Play different versions of "chase" with your toddler. You can play freeze tag, where you chase each other and

the person freezes when tagged. You can simply play tag and the person who gets tagged is now "It." You can give a good tickle when you catch the person being chased. Whatever you decide to do, talk about how God made a way for Moses and the Israelites to escape when the Egyptian army was chasing them.
