SMALL TALK

WEEK 1

EXODUS 1:21-2:10

Moses' mother puts him inside a basket and tells his sister, Miriam, to hide him among the reeds on the bank of the Nile. The Pharaoh's daughter finds him and adopts him as her son.

WEEK 2

EXODUS 3

God uses a burning bush to speak to Moses about His plan to set His people free from the Egyptian Pharaoh.

WEEK 3

EXODUS 13:17-14:31

God parts the Red Sea for Moses and the Israelites as the Egyptians are chasing them, so they can cross safely.

WEEK 4

EXODUS 13:21-22

God uses a cloud by day and fire by night to show Moses and the Israelites the right way to go.

WEEK 5

EXODUS 17:1-7

Moses needs water for God's people, and God shows him the way to get it.





MORNING TIME

This month let your child wake up to, "Good morning! Who's ready to go God's way today? I am!"



CAR TIME

This month for drive time, talk about the way you are going with your child as you drive. As you talk about going "this way and that way," tell your child that when we go God's way we are always going the right way, because God's way is perfect!



BATH TIME

As your child plays in the bath water, talk about how Moses and the Israelites couldn't go anywhere because the water in front of them was so big! But then God did something only He can do. He showed them the way to go by parting the water and making a dry path where they could walk. Ask your child to try and part the water in the tub by pushing it to the sides with their hands. Nope, can't do it. Only God can do that!



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle up with your child and pray. "Dear God, Your way is always the right way. I believe that with all of my heart. I pray that (*name of child*) will grow up wanting to follow the way You show them and will also believe Your way is always perfect. Thank You for showing us the way to go. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



PLAY TIME

Make a favorite cupcake or cookie recipe with your child. Talk about how the recipe shows you the way to make your yummy treat. As you eat, talk about how God shows us the right way to go in the Bible.



Have you ever thought of your life as a great adventure? Think about it. Adventures have exciting points. They have low points. They are full of anticipation and emotion. Adventures are awesome, and your life is one.

And, we all know adventures are better with ones we love. Our lives are the greatest adventures, and the One who loves us the most is right there with us, every step of the way.

What's even more awesome is that God has a plan for our great adventure, and it is perfect. God's way may not always be easy, but it is perfect. We're teaching your preschoolers that 'God's way is perfect' by following the life of Moses. Take some time this month to open your Bibles to the book of Exodus and read about Moses' great adventure. Then, pray and ask God to show you the way you should go just as He showed Moses and enjoy the adventure God has written for you.
