



## All-Church Bible Reading Plan

On Sundays this fall we're going to study some great Bible passages about walking with God. But we also want to ground ourselves in a specific text that will help us to walk with Jesus: Luke & Acts. Both written by "Dr. Luke," they tell the two-part story of us all. The Gospel of Luke: What Jesus began to do and teach for our salvation. The Book of Acts: What Jesus continues to do and teach—through his people—to save and restore the world. So the idea is simple this: Read a chapter a day starting on Monday, September 14. There are 52 chapters to cover over a 70-day teaching series, so there is plenty of grace worked into the schedule!

You can use a standard Bible, or follow along with the YouVersion Bible App. Here's how to tap into our reading plan:

1. Download the YouVersion Bible App.
2. Click on Plans (the check mark at the bottom of the page).
3. Type "Luke and Acts" into the search bar.
4. Select "BibleProject | Luke & Acts" and then click "Start Plan."
5. Select "With Friends" to read along with your family, friends, and small group. You can invite up to 150 people to do the plan along with you.
6. Select the start date: "Monday, September 14."
7. Click on the green circle and "Invite your Friends," either through the app or via text or email.

Tips for using the App:

- Start by clicking "Devotional." This will take you to a Bible Project video. (But please note there is not a devotional for every day of the study.)
- Proceed to the next page by clicking the green circle in the lower right corner.
- You can switch between Bible versions while reading.
  - At the top of the screen you will see the chapter and version you are in (i.e. Luke 1 NIV)
  - Click on your current version and a drop-down of other options appears.
  - Our Willowdale Kids team recommends the New International Reader's Version (NIRV)
- "Talk it Over" with friends doing the plan with you. Click "Write your response..." to send a message.
  - You can come back later to see what others have said.
  - You can like their message by clicking on the heart or leave a response.
